Junk Yacht **BOLEH**

The Boleh Trust (Charity No 1135117), was set up in 2009 to restore the 40ft historic junk yacht BOLEH (which means 'can do' in Malay). Built in Singapore by Malay shipwrights after World War II, BOLEH was sailed to England by her owner and designer, Commander Robin Kilroy DSC, in 1950. BOLEH arrived in Portsmouth on a low loader almost 10 years ago to start a lengthy restoration, financed by the Heritage Lottery Fund. The Project included an apprentice school to train local young people as shipwrights and also involve pupils from a nearby inner city Academy. Finally returned to the water in 2015, BOLEH is a working heritage vessel (National Historic Ship 2281) based in Chichester Harbour.



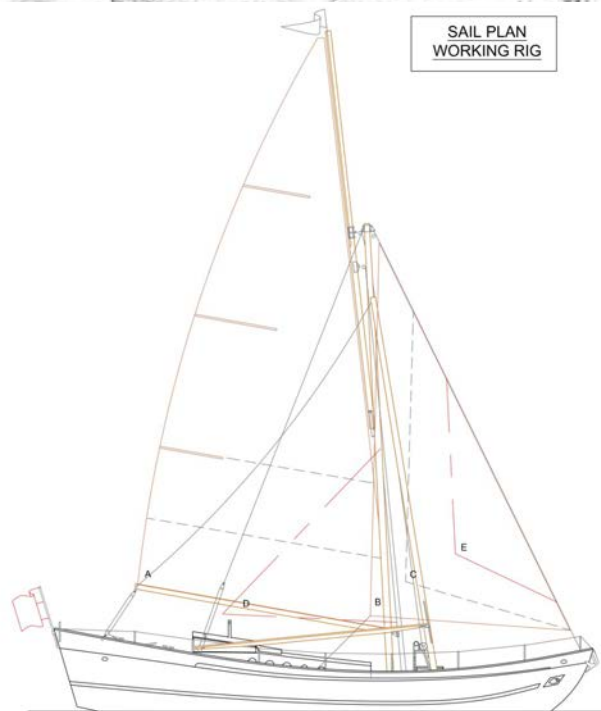
This beautifully restored junk yacht is MCA coded and now works with South Coast charities to sail disadvantaged young people and adults using our fully qualified skippers and mates. Designed for ocean cruising with a fusion of Eastern and Western traditions, BOLEH has a unique quadruped mast, a long keeled sea kindly hull, teak decks, and roomy living space with 8 berths and teak joinery. Restored to her 1949 layout, BOLEH is fitted with 21st century systems and is MCA coded, Category 2 for 8 persons and Category 4 for 12 persons.

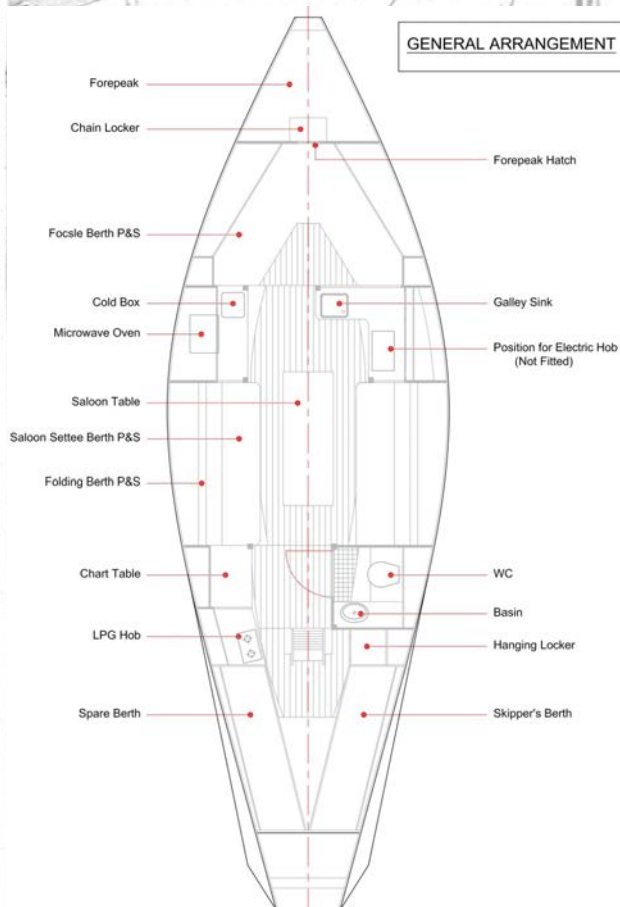
